Benefits of getting an assessment

Workplace / school adjustments to support preferences and, or needs: This can reduce anxieties at work, help with workplace fulfilment and job satisfaction.

Autistic people are protected under the Equality Act: This offers legal protections so an employer should make adjustments with any known condition.

An autistic child may get extra formal school support via EHCP: This will follow them throughout their schooling so no need to re-explain their needs every academic year.

You can access NHS and other sources of support specific for autistic people: Local NHS services will promote local in person and online support offers.

There may be funding available for equipment / adjustments in the workplace: These are often accessed via Employee Assistance Programmes or HR support.

Autistic university students may be eligible for Disability Student Allowance (DSA) assistance: Student support services can communicate with the course leaders and look to see required adjustments and any equipment needed which DSA funds can pay for.

If autism impacts day to day functioning, or ability to work, it can influence financial support, i.e. PIP payments: This is all determined by further assessments relating to employability assessments.
